Business Continuity deals with foreseeable operational disruptions and routine chance events, whereas Crisis Management deals with significant strategic consequences that threaten the viability or strategic integrity of the organisation.

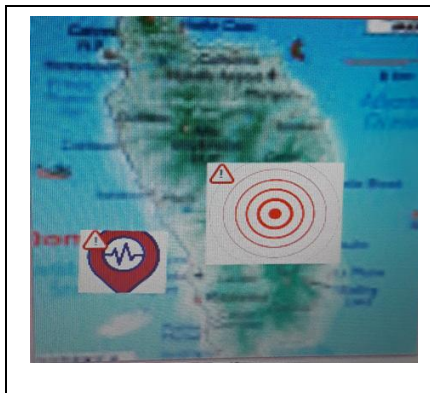
